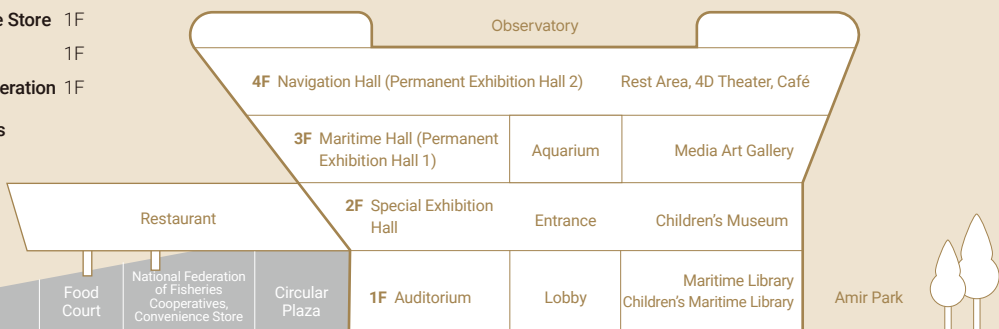

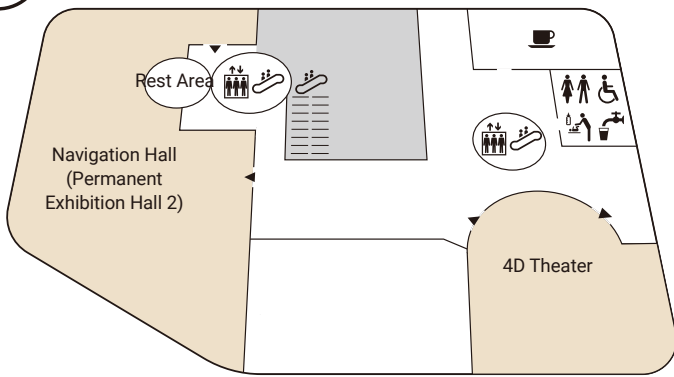

4F **Facilities** Navigation Hall (Permanent Exhibition Hall 2), 4D Theater, Café, Mother's Nursing Room, Rest Area



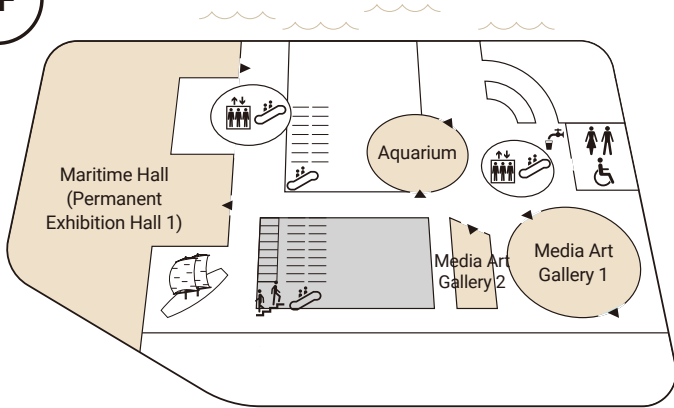

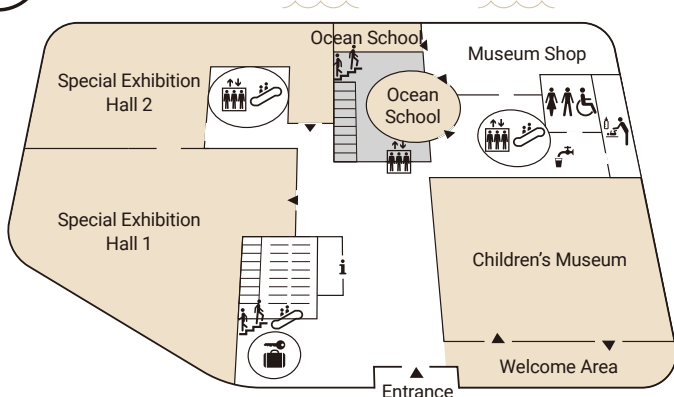
Aquarium Functioning as both a marine animal rescue and treatment facility and an ex-situ conservation facility, the aquarium is home to approximately 70 species and over 1,000 marine creatures.

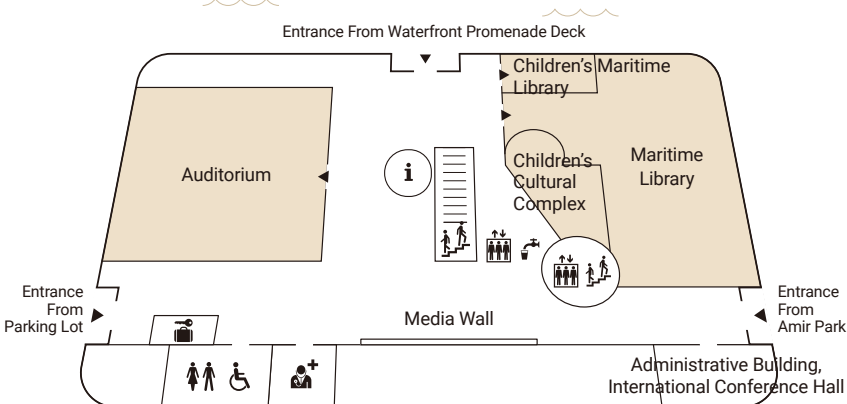

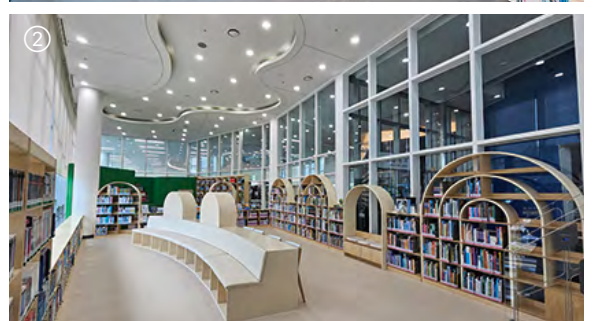
① Special Exhibition Hall, ② Children's Museum
